You will be creating a character portrait on one of the following characters:

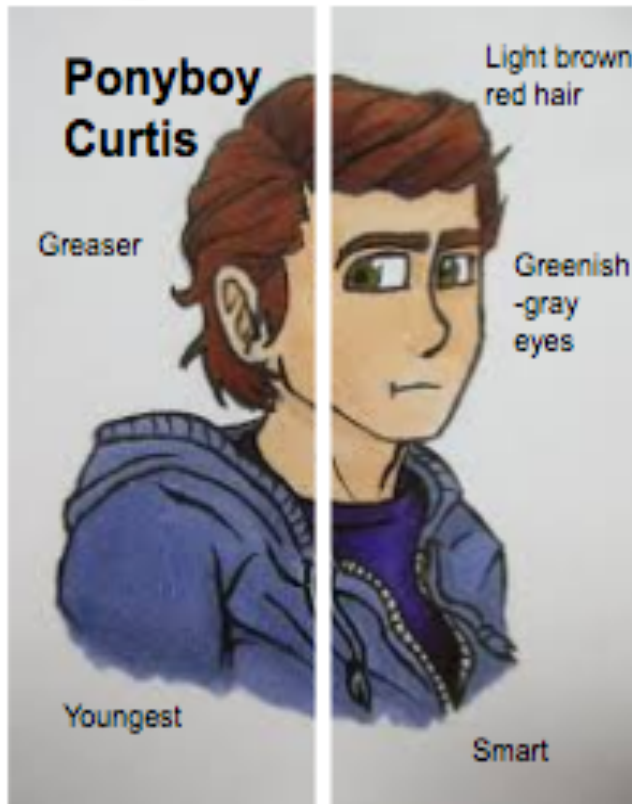
- Darryl (Darry) Curtis
